California Energy Commission staff will conduct a workshop to discuss the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) provisions as they pertain to the disbursement of funds for specific energy related projects. The workshop will focus on Assembly Bill 811 (Levine, Chapter 159, Statutes of 2008) and other funding mechanisms that finance the installation of energy efficiency improvements, distributed generation and renewable energy sources through contractual assessments to determine if and how ARRA money can best be used to advance these programs in local jurisdictions. Commissioners from both the California Energy Commission and the California Public Utilities Commission may be in attendance at this workshop. This workshop is intended to inform and discuss with the public and various stakeholders the types of projects that may be funded, eligible recipients of funds, application processes, and related timelines.
